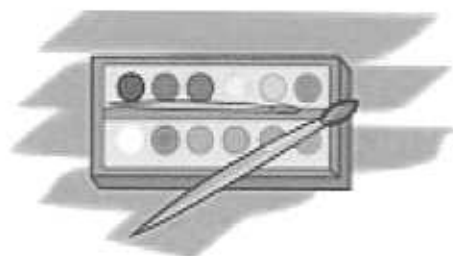


Beginner's Watercolor Materials List

Required:

- Pencil and eraser
- Watercolor paper (minimum of 15 sheets)
 - 90 lb
 - 11" X 15"
- 4 Brushes (rounds, natural fiber or synthetic): at least one from each size group below
 - 0-2
 - 4-6
 - 8-12
 - 3/4" or 1" flat
- Small sponge, natural or synthetic no larger than 10 cubic inches
- Paint set (pan with cakes or tubes) with at least 8 colors
 - If you are purchasing single tubes, here's suggested colors
 - Cadmium Yellow
 - Cadmium Red and/or Alizarin Crimson
 - Viridian and/or Sap Green
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Burnt Umber and/or Raw Umber
 - Yellow Ochre and/or Raw Sienna
 - Chinese White
 - Ivory Black
- Plastic Palette with several compartments
- Container for water, at least 12 oz.
- Paper towels or rags



Optional:

- Art box or fishing tackle box with adjustable compartments
- Old toothbrush
- Hair dryer
- Fan brush and any other size paint brushes you'd like to use
- Apron or paint shirt
